Date: Sunday, October 2, 2022

Location: Start in the rear of the Manchester Police Department (405 Valley Street, Manchester, NH) and end inside Gill Stadium (396 Valley Street, Manchester, NH)

Time: 5K timed road race commences at 10:15 am. Registration begins in the Manchester Police Department parking lot at 8:30 am. The after party begins immediately following the race inside Gill Stadium.

Race Fees: \$35 (Ages 18+), \$25 (Ages 17 and under) in advance; \$35 (Ages 18+), \$30 (Ages 17 and under) day-of
